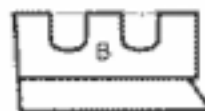
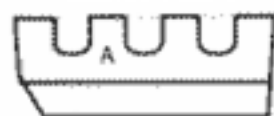


Stained Glass News

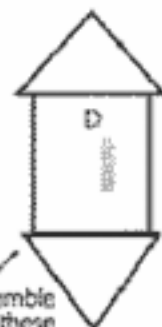
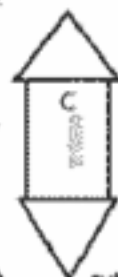
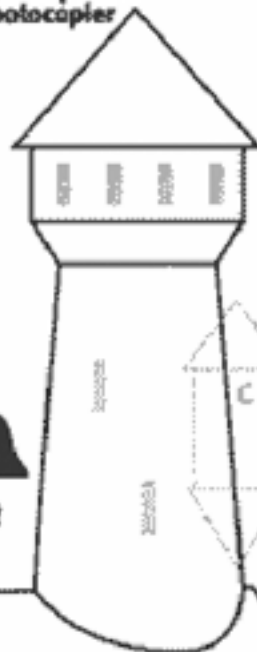
For a larger castle, enlarge this pattern on a photocopier

- 1) Cut, foil, assemble and solder all the project parts (patterns with black lines)
- 2) Paint on all the windows and doors (shaded areas) with black glass paint
- 3) Overlay the smaller sections (A-E) on top of the castle background and solder in place, using the dotted lines and letters as guides
- 4) Reinforce the edges with wire
- 5) Solder hanging ring(s) securely into seam(s) or overlay the entire finished castle onto a sheet of "sky" glass.

Note: You can use a 1/8" grinder bit to shape the top pieces on overlays A & B, or cut them straight (dotted lines).
