Spectrum Glass Color Suggestions

| A. 528-1RR | Sea Green Rough Rolled |
| B. 1/347-1s | Iridescent Pale Purple/White |
| C. 200SF | Opal White |
| D. 142SF | Light Purple Cathedral |
| E. 220-76SF | Opalized Dark Green |
| F. 240-72SF | Opalized Mauve |
| G. 130.8SF | Pale Blue Cathedral |
| H. 260-72SF | Opalized Yellow |

1. Fuse the eggs.

Layer 1: Cut 3 pieces 100SFS (Clear base) in the shape of the three individual eggs.

Layer 2: Cut pattern pieces as shown. Stack second layer on top of clear base.

Fuse eggs according to your established kiln procedures or refer to System 96® Firing Guidelines.*

2. Assemble project using copper foil.

Note: Eggs may be completed using copper foil instead of fusing if desired.
