

Spectrum Glass Color Suggestions

A. 200SF Opal White
B. 121SF Light Green Cathedral
C. 151SF Cherry Red Cathedral
D. 543-2SF Grape Cathedral
E. 161SF Yellow Cathedral

F. 523-2SF Teal Green Cathedral

Cut one square from 200SF Opal White to use as base. (Size = perimeter of pattern.) Build plaid design on top of base. (Strips are 1/2" wide.) Fuse according to your established kiln procedures or refer to System 96® Firing and Annealing Guidelines.*

After fusing, drill hole for clock movement.
